Over the last couple of months in pre-school we have been very busy focussing

on weather and looking at changes, we have been going on walks to the woods and collecting lots of natural objects, some of us even found Mushrooms! Which were just there—growing! We did not touch them or eat them!

We have also been enjoying our re-arranged room, we have been busy moving the room around so the children keep stimulated when at Nursery, so it is not the same old same old all the time. We have really enjoyed the changes and have lots of new areas to play in and adapt to our imaginations.

We have also been focussing lots on technology recently and have been exploring our light table and computer with a particular fondness for the program 'Rainbow Street' which looks at different Occupations, this is the theme we based our festive board around also.

During October we looked at pumpkins and what we can do with them to decorate them for Halloween! We went out for a walk to see what other decorations were in the neighbourhood. On the walk we saw a scary house all decorated we then came home back and decorated our own pumpkins.

Over November we have been looking and talking about fireworks night by making pictures and discussing why we have fireworks!

We have also had some more fires here at Busikids with our fire pit—we have 'magic powder' too that changes the colours of the flames!

During this month we have also talked about remembrance day and held a 2 minute silence, the children were great at doing this and we talked about why we did it.

Wow! What a busy few months we have had here in the Monkey Room.

In September the children loved getting messy! We explored paint using a variety of different resources and tried mark making in different ways, making spotty pictures with cotton buds was a particular hit.

This was a great way to promote our fine motor skills which are part of the physical development area of the EYFS. We also really enjoyed making some yummy pizza' for dinner. We spoke about all of the different ingredients we have been using which sparked a conversation about our favourite foods.

October came and we were able to observe big changes in our natural environment. The Monkey room children enjoyed looking out of the big windows shouting out what the weather is doing. We have also been on lots of walks to collect natural resources such as sticks, leaves and conkers which we have used in different ways such as collaging and alongside playdough play. Doing this meant we have been able to carefully look at the world around us.

In November we have celebrated Bonfire Night. We were lucky enough to hear some lovely conversations between the children about their trips to see fireworks. They spoke about the colours and noises they made. This was a wonderful way of supporting children's communication and language skills.

We also enjoyed Nursery Rhyme week singing lots of different songs and making props to support our singing such as lots of little sheep

Please could I remind everyone that now the weather is changing, could we please have appropriate outdoor wear such as welly boots, hats, gloves and warm winter coats. Thank you

We hope you are all enjoying the mild weather (although it is changing rapidly!) we are still having as the children are and it is a pleasure that we taking every opportunity to go out into the garden and experience the changes that are happening around us.

Permanent Room Supervisor—welcome back!

The team have come up with some fantastic Autumn ideas over the past weeks, using the children's interests to introduce them into the room: we have blended different textures amongst the small world resources so the outside is being brought inside (leaves, twigs etc).

We have been on Autumn walks, chasing falling leaves and experiencing the sounds from beneath our feet as we crunched around. Within the room we have introduced activities that encourage the children to "listen and Understand" these activities were again based on the children's current interests (we all like to have a boogie whatever the moves are!) Dancing to action nursery rhyme songs, the children have their favourites ad their little eyes light up when shown the CD. We also really enjoy any ball games, so listening for their names being called out helps to "play co0operatively with adults" (PSED—making relationships) but also helps them learn that some things are theirs: some things are shared (PSED" managing feelings and behaviour)

Over the past few weeks the children have been drinking their milk from cups with no lids and as each day goes by we are getting less spillages. (drinking from cups with no lids helps to strengthen their mouth muscles which helps with speech development)

As Christmas approaches, new exciting ideas for the children to learn from will appear for you all to look at and enjoy and these will be posted on Busikids Instagram and Face Book, some are simple using resources that we use everyday and can be repeated at home

I would like to welcome Chill as a permanent team member here in the Penguin room, she is such a great asset. I would also like to thank Toran and Kira for their ideas that they contribute to the team to help the children move forward in their development.

In the new Year we will be looking more about Winter and being on this topic I would like to remind you to ensure the children have warm coats etc and also a spare change of clothes as we will get wet and muddy as we continue to play outside

(The children do love a puddle to splash in, or mud to play with!)


